## Newark Man, 4 Feet 10, Says He Was Smallest in A. E. F.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 29 (AP) — Nicholas Casse of Newark, N. J., wants to be known as the world's smallest man who served in France with the American Expeditionary Forces.

He has applied to Representative Hartley of New Jersey to establish that fact. Casse recently secured an affidavit from the Veterans' Bureau certifying that he was a feet 10 inches tall and weighed 100 pounds when he returned. The bureau has refused to deliver him the "smaller man," saying it would require months for clerks to make the record of every man who served with the A. E. F.

It was just rejected from Casse's request for a certificate when the minimum requirements are 5 feet and 120 pounds.
